



**DAY 1 : MARSEILLE ARRIVAL 19JUN2025**

Welcome to FRANCE!

[NH Collection Marseille](#), where we will Check in and Rest from the long journey to be at leisure.

WELCOME Evening Dinner – a 3-Course Meal with 1 drink.

1 night in Marseille at 4\* hotel as per inclusions, centrally located.

**DAY 2 : MARSEILLE – SAINT MAXIMIN LA SAINTE BAUME 20JUN2025**

Breakfast at hotel and check out. Meet in the Lobby to Gather in ONENESS for the Journey up to [Saint Maximin La Sainte Baume](#) – A charming drive up the Mountain to this very quaint town in the Provence-Alpes-Côte d’Azur Region of Southeastern France which offers a blend of history, culture, and natural beauty. Whether you’re interested in religious history, exploring the Provençal countryside, or simply relaxing in a charming town, Saint-Maximin has something to offer.

Arrival to IBIS Saint Maximin 3\* Check in. Enjoy Evening Dinner – 3-Course Meal with 1 drink.

4 nights in Saint Maximin La Sainte Baume at 3\* hotel as per inclusions.

**DAY 3 : LA SAINTE BAUME CAVE VISIT 21JUN2025**

Breakfast at hotel. Depart from Hotel onto our First Visit to the La Sainte-Baume Cave, a significant pilgrimage site. We will take the Coach to the Base of the Mountain and with the Tour Guide we

will take our time to Hike up the Mountain, Resting along the way for a Message from the Masters of this Sacred Forest we are walking in. Resting for 20 minutes to drink or snack approx. before continuing.

***\*\*Please note: There is a 45 minute to 1 hour walking distance to reach the Magdalene Caves  
You must be Physically in good condition and well equipped for this climb.***

The Sainte-Baume Cave is a Sacred Spiritual Portal that we will align into the Stillness and receive the Essence of Grace, Holiness and Sacredness of Mary Magdalene and Jesus. Chapel to sit down.

#### The Journey to the Cave:

- Scenic Hike: Reaching the cave involves a pleasant but sometimes challenging hike through the surrounding forest. The most popular route is the "Chemin des Rois" (King's Path), a wide trail with some steep sections and steps. The walk takes about 45 minutes to an hour, offering beautiful views of the landscape.

Forest Atmosphere: The path winds through a dense, Ancient Forest, adding to the feeling of being on a special journey. The forest itself is a protected area, known for its rich biodiversity.

#### A Sacred Grotto:

Mary Magdalene's Refuge: This cave is believed to be where Mary Magdalene, a prominent figure in the New Testament, spent the last years of her life in prayer and contemplation after the crucifixion of Jesus. It's a significant pilgrimage site to enjoy the Essence of the Feminine

Natural Wonder: The cave itself is a natural Grotto carved into the sheer cliff face of Sainte-Baume mountain Atmosphere of Peacefulness and Reverence for this impressive Cave of a Mystery of Time



#### Inside the Cave:

Spiritual Ambiance: The cave has been transformed into a Sanctuary, with a small Chapel and religious artifacts. The atmosphere is peaceful and contemplative, inviting visitors to reflect and connect with the history and spirituality of the place.

Cool Temperatures: Even in the summer, the cave maintains a cool temperature (around 13°C or 55°F), so it's a good idea to bring a light jacket or sweater.

**\*\*Things to Consider\*\*:**

Accessibility: The cave is only accessible by foot, so be prepared for a hike. Wear comfortable shoes and bring water, fruit as we will take a break and sit in the Forest for a Message from the Masters.

Respectful Attire: As a religious site, it's recommended to dress respectfully when visiting the cave.

Photography: Photography may be restricted in certain areas of the cave

Afterwards, We will return to the Coach and head back to our Hotel for Rest and Dinner as you like Overnight in Saint Maximin La Sainte Baume.

**DAY 4 : SAINT MAXIMIN LA SAINTE BAUME 22JUN2025**

Breakfast at hotel. Today enjoy a Guided Tour to the Basilica of Saint Mary Magdalene and exploration of the town.

Basilica of Saint Mary Magdalene is a stunning Gothic Basilica in the Town's Centerpiece. It's one of the most important Pilgrimage Sites in Christendom, believed to house the Relics of Mary Magdalene. The Basilica's architecture boasts of intricate Stained Glass of Historical Significance. Afterwards, we return to the Hotel for a leisurely afternoon, shopping, enjoying the Culture.

Dinner as you wish and Overnight in Saint Maximin La Sainte Baume.

**DAY 5 : SAINT MAXIMIN LA SAINTE BAUME 23JUN2025**

Breakfast at hotel. Today we will have a FREE Day to explore the surrounding area and attractions at your own pace. Enjoy exploring the Town and local shops. Optional Meet up for Dinner together 😊

Overnight in Saint Maximin La Sainte Baume.

**DAY 6 : SAINT MAXIMIN LA SAINTE BAUME – MARSEILLE 24JUN2025**

Breakfast at hotel and check out for our last night in Saint Maximin as we head back to Marseille. Along the way, we will visit [Saintes Maries de la Mer](#) - Town in the Camargue Region of France with significant Religious importance.

**Known Attraction:** the fortified Church of Notre-Dame-de-la-Mer (*\*entrance not included*), dedicated to Mary and the Three Marys' who, legend says, brought Christianity to the area.

The Church's Crypt houses the [Statue of Saint Sara](#), Patron Saint of the Romani people, making it a key Pilgrimage Site, especially for the Romani during their May Pilgrimage.

Town also holds other Religious Festivals and contains Religious Art within the Church. A place where Christian Tradition and Romani devotion intersect, offering a rich Spiritual Experience.

We continue on our Journey to stop at [Abbaye St. Victor to visit Chapel of Black Madonna](#) (*\*entrance not included*).

We will settle into the Stillness *to sit with this Statue and receive Messages from the Masters of the Feminine Energies that we are Activating into Oneness.*

After visiting this Town and finding a Light Lunch along the way we will head to Marseille Hotel Check in and Free time for leisure and Integrating these past few days of the Feminine Energies **[Evening Dinner – a 3-course meal with 1 drink.](#) 1<sup>st</sup> of 3 nights in this 4\* Hotel in Marseille**

**DAY 7 : AVIGNON AND CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE 25JUN2025**

Breakfast in the Morning before heading out for a full day Excursion for a Private Tour to Avignon and Châteauneuf-du-Pape from Marseille. Breath taking blend of history, culture, and of course the Wine in the heart of Provence.

Coach and Driver will take us on a scenic drive to Avignon through the Provençal countryside, with its vineyards, olive groves, and charming villages.

Upon arrival to Avignon we will visit:

Palais des Papes - The magnificent Palais des Papes, a UNESCO World Heritage Site is one of the largest and most important Gothic Palaces in Europe. We will wander through its Grand Halls, Chapels, and Courtyards, imagining the lives of the Popes who once resided here.

Pont d'Avignon: The iconic Pont d'Avignon (officially known as the Pont Saint-Bénézet), a famous bridge with a fascinating history as we enjoy the views of the Rhône River and the city.

Avignon's Old Town: Take a stroll through the charming streets of Avignon's old town, with its Medieval Architecture, Squares, and Shops. Perhaps have lunch at a traditional Provençal restaurant.

Afterwards, drive to Châteauneuf-du-Pape a renowned Wine Region in the Rhône Valley. Explore the charming village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, with its hilltop Castle Ruins and panoramic views of the surrounding vineyards. You can also visit the wine cellars and shops in the village (\*entrance fees and meals not included).

In the evening, we return to Marseille Hotel for a relaxing evening.

**DAY 8 : MARSEILLE 26JUN2025**

Leisure/Shop/Souvenir Day Breakfast then enjoy the last day as you wish to explore the boardwalks, Shops and Mediterranean Sea of Marseille before we say our Good-bye to these wonders of France.

Evening Farewell Dinner – 3-Course Meal with 1 drink. Final night in Marseille.

**DAY 9 : MARSEILLE DEPARTURE 27JUN2025**

Breakfast at hotel and check out. Private Transfer to Marseille Airport
